High-quality colostrum concentrate for newborn piglets

## How to Use Pigolo Colostrum

Early intervention and frequent administration are essential!

### FIRST 24 HOURS:

- Feed Pigolo colostrum to all weak piglets in the litter immediately after birth – preferably within the first hour.
- Provide Pigolo colostrum at least 1–2 times before sorting.
- Thereafter, each piglet should receive Pigolo colostrum 3–4 times during the first 24 hours.

### DAY 2 AND 3:

- On the second and third day, it is usually sufficient to administer Pigolo colostrum 2–3 times daily.
- Some piglets may need more – others less.
- The goal is for each piglet to receive approximately 50 ml of Pigolo colostrum in total over the first three days, to gain the strength needed to nurse from the sow.

### IMPORTANT!

Allow piglets unrestricted access to Pigolo colostrum during the first 24 hours – the faster they receive colostrum and energy, the sooner they will be able to suckle from the sow on their own. This also means that less Pigolo will be needed overall.
