

PIGOLO

Practical instructions



The 100 mL colostrum bottles must be stored in a freezer (-18 °C / -1 °F or lower).



The bottles are thawed in a waterbath in warm water (45-55 °C / 113-131 °F) for 20-30 minutes before use.

NOTE: At temperatures above 60 °C / 140 °F important nutrients are destroyed. The product must be used immediately after thawing (feeding temperature approx 30-40 °C / 86-104 °F) within 3-4 hours.



Start feeding:

Give unlimited Pigolo colostrum to all weak piglets in the litter immediately after birth. The first dose should preferably be given within the first hour, and 1–2 times before sorting. Thereafter, administer 3–4 times during the first 24 hours. On days 2 and 3: Feed approximately 2–3 times per day.



The rest should be used or discarded within 4-5 hours of thawing, to limit harmful bacteria growth.
